

Brian Freund, MPT, MBA, CSMT

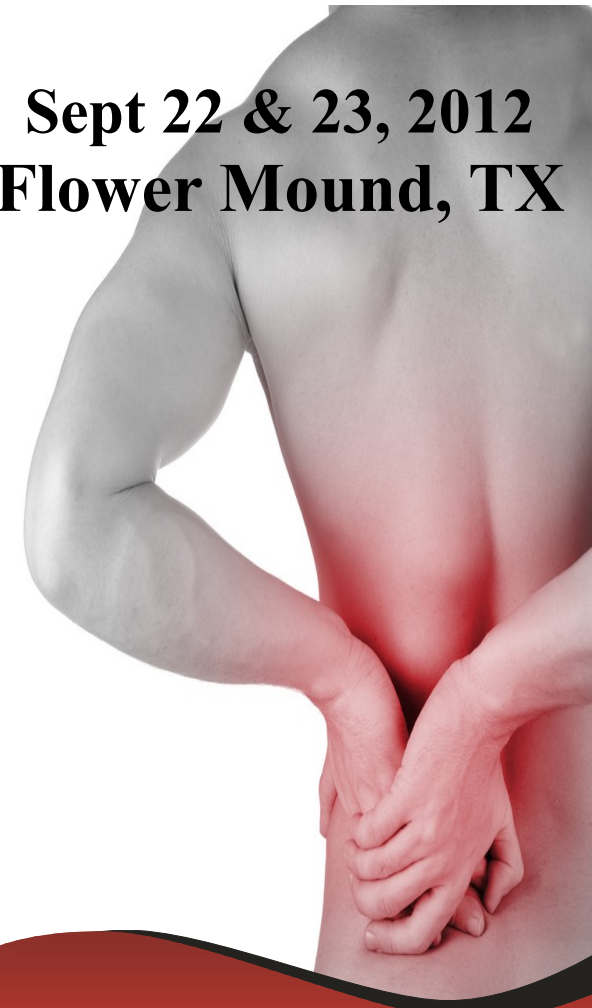
